2. ENGLISH CAMP FOR CHILDREN

As with last year, we are offering missionaries the option of going to the construction site or participating in an English Bible Study Day Program in a School built by the Samaritan Foundation. The new Asher School, completed in 2016, can accommodate up to 600 students and hosts a mix of Haitian and Dominican children whose families live and work in a nearby city dump. The average family working at the dump makes an average of \$1 USD a day. Helping children begin learn conversational English would go a long way in helping them rise above their systemic poverty as tourism is a major industry in the Dominican Republic. About 300 children are expected to participate in the week-long program.

- Work with children to learn basic English terms
- Use Music, Arts and Crafts, and Sports to get them comfortable with speaking English.
- o Provide Lunch for the children.
